


## Class 2 Curriculum Coverage

<p><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>The whole federation is starting the term exploring the stimulating picture book 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. Children from nursery to Year 6 will delve deep into the magical world and share their thoughts and writing across the age groups. Our class reading book is Beowulf, complementing our work in history.</p>
<p><b>Numeracy</b></p> 	<p>Our usual rolling programme, starting off with a long and in depth unit of work on fractions, decimals and percentages. Children will be embedding and extending their reasoning and problem solving skills this term.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>We are moving into physics this term, with a topic on forces and magnets. Our emphasis this term will be on designing and conducting experiments and working scientifically.</p>
<p><b>History and Geography</b></p> 	<p>Our topic of Vikings and Saxons promises all sorts of exciting learning adventures including invaders, kingdoms, settlements and ancient mysteries.</p>
