Phonics

We will be learning to listen to different sounds and rhythms to help us tune into sounds.

Some children will be learning how to say the sound and name of a letter and how to blend sounds to make words.

Number

We will be learning numbers to 10 and the children will be looking at numerals and matching them to amounts. They will also be learning about 2D shapes and they will compare size and weight.

Through the story 'Over in the Meadow' the children will be learning about rhyme, numbers and animals in the environment. They will also be looking at their senses and how we use them.
