This week we held a whole school maths week where the children learnt maths through most areas of the curriculum. They have built rockets from nets, and then measured how far they could fly by launching them from plastic bottle rocket launchers, they have compared the planets of the Solar System in terms of diameter, perimeter and distance from the sun, and they have explored probability and tessellating patterns and solved French maths puzzles. During PE they measured distance and time, and in literacy the Juniors wrote to their favourite celebrity to ask how they use maths in their work.



This morning the infants managed to persuade Mrs Wyatt that they should explore how much maths is involved in baking a cake, they all enjoyed the outcome!
